Become a volunteer with the Canadian Red Cross and help your local community as part of the largest humanitarian organization in the world! There are opportunities to help your neighbours in Saskatchewan that suit your interests and skill sets. In addition to personal fulfillment, volunteering with the Red Cross offers you the chance to enhance your:

- Team work and collaboration skills
- Communication and interpersonal skills
- » Problem solving and analytical skills
- Organizational skills
- Customer service and client service delivery skills

Emergency Response Team

Support people and communities affected by large-scale disasters like forest fires or flooding. Work could include:

- » Registering families from evacuated communities
- » Distributing supplies in an emergency shelter
- Organizing activities for children in an emergency shelter



Personal Disaster Assistance Team

Support people affected by small-scale disasters such as house fires by providing for basic needs for the first 72 hours. Work could include:

- Meeting with families experiencing a disaster
- Carrying an on-call phone to ensure assistance is avail able 24/7
- Coordinating with hotel partners to provide a safe place for clients to go



Safety and Wellbeing

Support the emotional needs of individuals in communities experiencing crisis or disaster and through long-term recovery. Work could include:

- Meeting with clients in an emergency shelter
- » Developing referral lists
- » Advocating for those with special needs



Volunteer Opportunities



Logistics Team

Ensure critical work can be done to support Red Cross clients by getting supplies and people where they need to be. Work could include:

- Coordinating the delivery of supplies, goods, and services
- » Finding and purchasing needed supplies
- Coordinating transportation during a disaster response



Friendly Phone Program

Help address loneliness by connecting with older isolated adults through weekly phone visits. Work could include:

- Making regular phone calls to clients
- » Providing referrals to community resources
- Monitoring and tracking changes in a client



People Services

Help unify the workforce of employees and volunteers, ensuring support to clients can be carried out effectively and efficiently. Work could include:

- Scheduling the volunteer workforce during an emergency response
- Coordinating and tracking travel arrangements for personnel
- » Ensuring accurate personnel data and records are in place



Philanthropy

Help raise funds that ensure the Red Cross can provide assistance when needed in Saskatchewan, across Canada and around the world. Work could include:

- » Helping to organize receptions/events
- Visiting community groups holding fundraisers for the Red Cross
- Providing administrative support to the Philanthropy team
